Washington High School and entered the U.S. Air Force, where he attained the rank of Master Sergeant, serving 26 years. During his years of service in the AF, he met his beloved wife of 53 years, Louise Harmon in Hawaii. They married in 1965. He retired and they made their home in Sacramento, CA. Deacon Harmon owned the Delta Janitorial Service, serving much of the Sacramento area
