OCT 29, 1966 - OCT 18, 2022

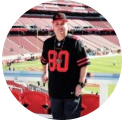

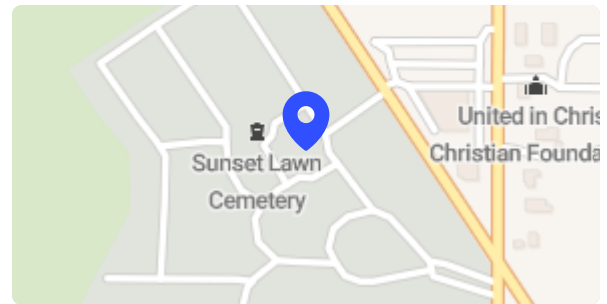

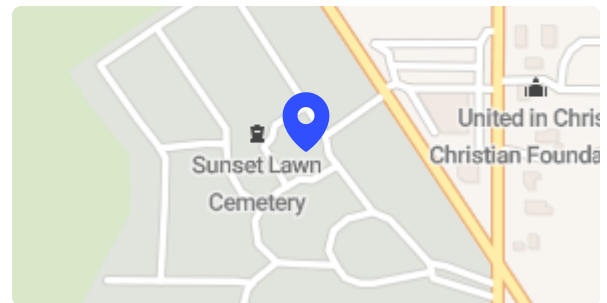
