He played Blackjack and Poker and was very good at it.

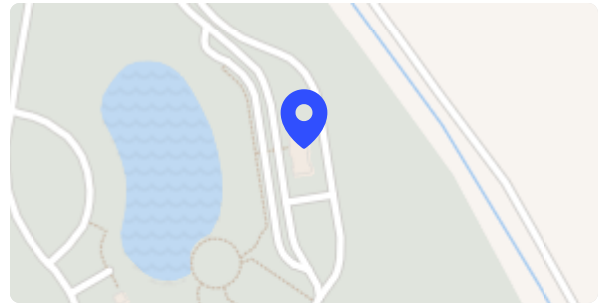

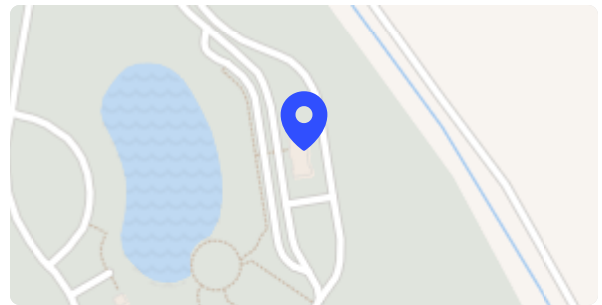
