She will be deeply missed by her family and friends, who will forever cherish the memories of her warmth, kindness, and the light she brought into their lives.

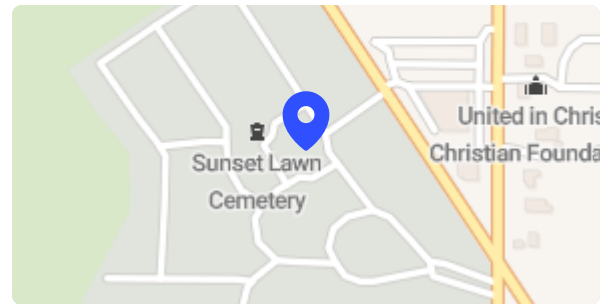

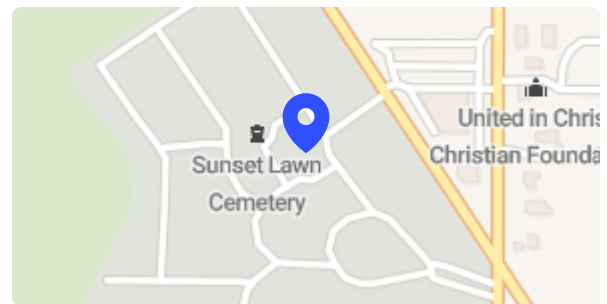
